ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR

NOTIFICATION

Dated Shillong, the 10th January, 2013.

No.HPL.164/2010/316 –Whereas for public convenience and better administration the Governor of Meghalaya considers it necessary to upgrade Shallang Out Post to a Police Station at Shallang in the West Khasi Hills District to be known as the Shallang Police Station;

And, whereas, it is necessary to describe the boundaries and jurisdiction of the new Police Station as indicated here-under;

Now, therefore, the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to order upgradation of the aforesaid Out Post into a new Police Station at Shallang and to describe the boundaries and jurisdiction of the New Police Station as indicated hereunder with effect from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette of Meghalaya. On creation of the Shallang Police Station, the areas coming under its jurisdiction shall cease to be under the Nongstoin Police Station.

DESCRIPTION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SHALLANG POLICE STATION

North : From Nongshram – Rongbeng village, the boundary runs in easterly direction through the village of Jingrunniangbrak, Nongmisie, Mawlang till it reaches Nongrengba village.

East : From Nongrengba village the boundary runs southwards through the hilly terrain of Nongtyra till it reaches Nongmawlai village bordering Nongstoin Police Station jurisdiction.

South : From Nongmawlai village, the boundary runs in the westerly direction through the village of Nongriangna, Thateja, Langmar, Khalu village till it touches Simsang River on the South Garo Hills border.

West : From Simsang River the boundary runs northwards towards Rongthok, Nengchigen and Thodmari village till it touches Ryndi river of East Garo Hills.
